

- **ALL homeowners, tenants, and guests must park off-street at the beginning of the snowfall.**
- **Keep your cars off the street. The plows make several passes before the snow removal process is completed.**
- **Members are required to shovel their sidewalks after the snow has stopped.**
- **Do not shovel the end of your driveway until plowing is completed.**
- **Do not plow, shovel or blow snow into the street.**

A snowfall may occur any time of the day or night. Likewise, snow removal can and does take place at any time. For this reason, it is essential that **all residents park off-street** when snow is forecasted.

Let's be very clear -- **Somerton Forge residents are required to park off-street when snow is forecasted.** This means you park in your garage and/or driveway when the weather calls for snow. If your car is parked on the street when it begins to snow, **you must immediately move your vehicle off the street.** Our roads must be free and clear for the snow plows to do their job.

We must get the most for our money and we must all be involved in seeing to it that we do.

The Board of Directors reassessed the enforcement policy regarding vehicles left on the street during a snowfall at the monthly Board meeting of January 16, 2001. It was decided that, to ensure the cooperation of all residents, the fine for failure to remove a vehicle from the street during a snowfall would be increased to **\$250 per incident, per vehicle.**

Members should be aware that this policy extends to all vehicles, including those of tenants, visitors and guests. There will be no further warnings regarding this matter. **Association members who disregard this policy will be fined.**
